YOUR EXHIBIT

We ask that you arrange to arrive on Thursday 3rd April to set up your displays.

The site will be set up for exhibits to arrive from Thursday 3 April 2008. We anticipate that Friday will be very busy and ask that exhibitors arrive on Thursday where possible to minimise the amount of set up on Friday.

The Heritage Village has benefited from the generosity of local businesses who have provided a crane and forklift equipment to assist with loading and unloading of equipment. A loading ramp is also installed.

An exhibitors car-park will be located in the Heritage Village Grounds to provide accessible and secure parking for exhibitors for the event. Exhibitors will be asked to confine their vehicles to this area while the event is open to the public.

Fire control and first aid equipment will be available on site for the duration of the event although exhibitors are encouraged to make their own arrangements as well to ensue the fastest possible response to incidents.

Un-powered camping sites will be available at the Heritage Village, this area is also available to caravans/campers and is adjacent to both the tractors and stationery engine display areas, camping with exhibits is discouraged. Security will be provided for the duration of the event to ensure that exhibits are displayed safely and securely
